- Be honest on a mortgage application.
- Do not apply for a mortgage for someone else.
- Contact the Commission to check the licence status of a mortgage broker or real estate professional.
- Avoid identity theft by protecting your personal information.
- Be wary of anyone who approaches you with an offer to make "easy money" in real estate.
